Allocation increase for Bega and Brogo regulated rivers general security water users

Department of Primary Industries Acting Deputy Director General Water, Bruce Cooper, today announced a 6 percent increase for general security water users drawing from the Brogo and Bega regulated rivers.

“This increase brings the general security allocation for this year to 66 percent of entitlement,” Mr Cooper said.

“Periodic coastal rainfall and inflows have seen Brogo Dam remain full,” Mr Cooper said

“So with system requirements being met from on-going surplus flows, it means that more water in storage is available for allocation,” he said.

Full allocations for all other licence categories were made at the commencement of the water year on 1 July 2014.

A further assessment will be undertaken next month and the results announced in mid-February 2015.
